Explanation of Responses:

- The reported shares are represented by restricted stock units, or RSUs, which vest as follows:(1) 50,000 RSUs vest in 48 equal monthly installments beginning on January 18, 2019 with vested shares to be settled beginning on January 30, 2020 and the remaining shares vest monthly thereafter and (ii) 155,000 RSUs vest in 16 equal quarterly installments beginning on August 25, 2019.
- An option to purchase 687,335 shares was granted on September 3, 2015 and was exercised in part prior to the date on which the reporting person became subject to Section 16. One-fourth of the shares subject to the option vested on September 1, 2016 and 1/48 of the shares vest monthly thereafter.
- One-fourth of the shares subject to the option vested on November 16, 2017 and 1/48 of the shares vest monthly thereafter.
- One-fourth of the shares subject to the option vested on June 19, 2019 and 1/48 of the shares vest monthly thereafter.
